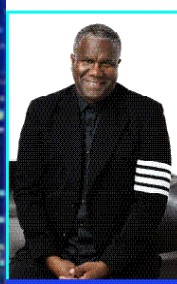

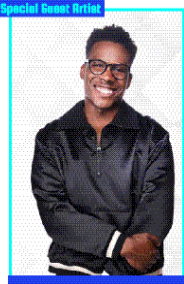

- 2. Reflect on who God is and grow in awareness of the character and nature of Him!** (Isaiah 26:3). The more we come to know and delight in Him, the more we can grow in loving and trusting Him!
- 3. Affirm who God says you are and walk in it!** (John 1:12). You do what you do because of what you think of you. Therefore, in all that we think, say, and do we must remind ourselves of the true identity we have in Christ, above all else!
